

200+ Verses to Help You Recognize the True Gospel

Recognizing that many additions have been made to the Gospel over the years, I have collected what I believe to be a fairly extensive list of those verses that refer directly or indirectly (but plainly—at least to anyone with a modicum of study background) to God’s plan for salvation.

The list will show conclusively that:

- The plan of salvation is the same now as at all times in the past. [That is, people in the Old Testament as well as in the New Testament were saved the same way that you are today. The only difference is that you now have more details.]
- The Gospel has never included things like, “Ask Jesus into your heart,” “Make Jesus your Lord and Master,” “Now pray the Sinner’s prayer,” or any of a host of other blatantly false add-ons.
- The true Gospel can be readily recognized by the verbs employed. They will include faith, belief, and trust. Outside of those few verbs, you are most likely dealing with an add-on.

So, here goes...

1. [Gen 15:6] And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.
2. [Rth 2:12] The LORD recompense thy work, and a full reward be given thee of the LORD God of Israel, under whose wings thou art come to trust.
3. [2Sa 22:3] The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.
4. [2Sa 22:31] As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him.
5. [1Ch 5:25] And they were helped against them, and the Hagarites were delivered into their hand, and all that were with them: for they cried to God in the battle, and he was intreated of them; because they put their trust in him.
6. [2Ch 20:25] And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.

7. [Job 13:15] Though he slay me, yet will I trust in him: but I will maintain mine own ways before him.
8. [Job 35:14] Although thou sayest thou shalt not see him, yet judgment is before him; therefore trust thou in him.
9. [Psa 2:12] Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.
10. [Psa 4:5] Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD.
11. [Psa 5:11] But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.
12. [Psa 9:15] And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.
13. [Psa 11:1] In the LORD put I my trust: how say ye to my soul, Flee as a bird to your mountain?
14. [Psa 16:1] Preserve me, O God: for in thee do I put my trust.
15. [Psa 17:7] Shew thy marvellous lovingkindness, O thou that savest by thy right hand them which put their trust in thee from those that rise up against them.
16. [Psa 18:2] The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.
17. [Psa 18:35] As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.
18. [Psa 20:7] Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God.
19. [Psa 25:2] O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.
20. [Psa 27:13] I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.
21. [Psa 31:6] I have hated them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the LORD.
22. [Psa 31:16] Make thy face to shine upon thy servant: save me for thy mercies'

sake.

23. [Psa 31:19] Oh how great is thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!
24. [Psa 32:15] Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.
25. [Psa 34:8] O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.
26. [Psa 34:22] The LORD redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate.
27. [Psa 36:7] How excellent is thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.
28. [Psa 37:3] Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.
29. [Psa 37:5] Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.
30. [Psa 40:3] And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.
31. [Psa 40:4] Blessed is that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.
32. [Psa 52:8] But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.
33. [Psa 54:1] <To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, A Psalm of David, when the Ziphims came and said to Saul, Doth not David hide himself with us?> Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.
34. [Psa 55:16] As for me, I will call upon God; and the LORD shall save me.
35. [Psa 55:23] But thou, O God, shalt bring them down into the pit of destruction: bloody and deceitful men shall not live out half their days; but I will trust in thee.
36. [Psa 56:3] What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee.
37. [Psa 56:4] In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.
38. [Psa 56:11] In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do

unto me.

39. [Psa 57:1] <To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David, when he fled from Saul in the cave.> Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in thee: yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until these calamities be overpast.
40. [Psa 61:4] I will abide in thy tabernacle for ever: I will trust in the covert of thy wings. Selah.
41. [Psa 62:8] Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah.
42. [Psa 64:15] The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.
43. [Psa 71:1] In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust: let me never be put to confusion.
44. [Psa 71:3] Be thou my strong habitation, whereunto I may continually resort: thou hast given commandment to save me; for thou art my rock and my fortress.
45. [Psa 71:5] For thou art my hope, O Lord GOD: thou art my trust from my youth.
46. [Psa 73:28] But it is good for me to draw near to God: I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all thy works.
47. [Psa 78:22] Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his salvation:
48. [Psa 78:32] For all this they sinned still, and believed not for his wondrous works.
49. [Psa 80:3] Turn us again, O God, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.
50. [Psa 80:7] Turn us again, O God of hosts, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.
51. [Psa 80:19] Turn us again, O LORD God of hosts, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.
52. [Psa 84:12] O LORD of hosts, blessed is the man that trusteth in thee.
53. [Psa 86:2] Preserve my soul; for I am holy: O thou my God, save thy servant that trusteth in thee.

54. [Psa 91:2] I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
55. [Psa 91:4] He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.
56. [Psa 109:26] Help me, O LORD my God: O save me according to thy mercy:
57. [Psa 115:9] O Israel, trust thou in the LORD: he is their help and their shield.
58. [Psa 115:15] O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield.
59. [Psa 115:11] Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield.
60. [Psa 118:8] It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man.
61. [Psa 118:9] It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes.
62. [Psa 119:42] So shall I have wherewith to answer him that reproacheth me: for I trust in thy word.
63. [Psa 125:1] <A Song of degrees.> They that trust in the LORD shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abideth for ever.
64. [Psa 138:7] Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me.
65. [Psa 141:8] But mine eyes are unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.
66. [Psa 143:8] Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee.
67. [Psa 144:2] My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and he in whom I trust; who subdueth my people under me.
68. [Psa 146:3] Put not your trust in princes, nor in the son of man, in whom there is no help.
69. [Pro 3:5] Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.
70. [Pro 16:25] He that handleth a matter wisely shall find good: and whoso trusteth in the LORD, happy is he.

71. [Pro 20:22] Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but wait on the LORD, and he shall save thee.
72. [Pro 22:19] That thy trust may be in the LORD, I have made known to thee this day, even to thee.
73. [Pro 28:25] He that is of a proud heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat.
74. [Pro 29:25] The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.
75. [Pro 30:5] Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.
76. [Isa 12:2] Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation.
77. [Isa 25:9] And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation.
78. [Isa 26:3] Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.
79. [Isa 26:4] Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:
80. [Isa 28:16] Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste.
81. [Isa 30:15] For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.
82. [Isa 33:22] For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; he will save us.
83. [Isa 43:15] Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.
84. [Isa 45:22] Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.
85. [Isa 50:15] Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice

of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God.

86. [Isa 51:5] My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust.
87. [Jer 17:7] Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.
88. [Jer 17:14] Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.
89. [Jer 23:6] In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.
90. [Jer 33:16] In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this is the name wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.
91. [Jer 49:11] Leave thy fatherless children, I will preserve them alive; and let thy widows trust in me.
92. [Dan 6:23] Then was the king exceeding glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God.
93. [Hos 1:7] But I will have mercy upon the house of Judah, and will save them by the LORD their God, and will not save them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen.
94. [Nah 1:7] The LORD is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.
95. [Hab 2:4] Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.
96. [Zep 3:12] I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD.
97. [Mat 8:13] And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.
98. [Mat 9:2] And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of

good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.

99. [Mat 12:21] And in his name shall the Gentiles trust.
100. [Mat 14:31] And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?
101. [Mat 15:28] Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.
102. [Mat 17:25] And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.
103. [Mat 18:6] But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.
104. [Mat 21:21] Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.
105. [Mar 1:15] And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.
106. [Mar 2:5] When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.
107. [Mar 5:34] And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.
108. [Mar 5:36] As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe.
109. [Mar 9:23] Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.
110. [Mar 9:42] And whosoever shall offend one of these little ones that believe in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea.
111. [Mar 10:52] And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
112. [Mar 11:22] And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

113. [Mar 11:23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
114. [Mar 11:24] Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
115. [Mar 16:16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
116. [Luk 5:25] And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee.
117. [Luk 7:55] And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.
118. [Luk 8:12] Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
119. [Luk 8:48] And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.
120. [Luk 8:55] But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.
121. [Luk 17:19] And he said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole.
122. [Luk 18:42] And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee.
123. [Joh 1:7] The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.
124. [Joh 1:12] But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:
125. [Joh 3:15] That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.
126. [Joh 3:16] For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
127. [Joh 3:18] He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

128. [Joh 3:36] He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
129. [Joh 5:24] Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.
130. [Joh 6:29] Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
131. [Joh 6:35] And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.
132. [Joh 6:45] And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.
133. [Joh 6:47] Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.
134. [Joh 7:38-39] He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)
135. [Joh 8:24] I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.
136. [Joh 11:25] Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
137. [Joh 11:26] And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?
138. [Joh 11:45] Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?
139. [Joh 12:36] While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them.
140. [Joh 12:46] I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
141. [Joh 14:12] Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

142. [Joh 16:31] Jesus answered them, Do ye now believe?
143. [Joh 17:25] Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;
144. [Joh 20:29] Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.
145. [Joh 20:31] But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.
146. [Act 8:12] But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
147. [Act 8:13] Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.
148. [Act 10:43] To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.
149. [Act 11:17] Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?
150. [Act 11:21] And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the Lord.
151. [Act 13:39] And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.
152. [Act 13:48] And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.
153. [Act 15:7] And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe.
154. [Act 15:9] And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.
155. [Act 15:11] But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.
156. [Act 16:31] And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt

be saved, and thy house.

157. [Act 18:8] And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized.
158. [Act 19:4] Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.
159. [Act 26:18] To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
160. [Rom 1:16] For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.
161. [Rom 1:17] For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.
162. [Rom 3:22] Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:
163. [Rom 3:25] Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;
164. [Rom 3:26] To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.
165. [Rom 3:28] Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.
166. [Rom 3:35] Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.
167. [Rom 4:3] For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
168. [Rom 4:5] But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.
169. [Rom 4:9] Cometh this blessedness then upon the circumcision only, or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.
170. [Rom 4:11] And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the

righteousness of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:

171. [Rom 4:13] For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.
172. [Rom 4:24] But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;
173. [Rom 5:1] Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:
174. [Rom 5:2] By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
175. [Rom 5:9] Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.
176. [Rom 9:35] What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of faith.
177. [Rom 9:32] Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone;
178. [Rom 10:4] For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.
179. [Rom 10:8] But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;
180. [Rom 10:9] That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
181. [Rom 10:15] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
182. [Rom 10:11] For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.
183. [Rom 10:13] For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
184. [Rom 10:17] So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

185. [Rom 11:25] Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear:
186. [Rom 15:12] And again, Esaias saith, There shall be a root of Jesse, and he that shall rise to reign over the Gentiles; in him shall the Gentiles trust.
187. [1Co 1:21] For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.
188. [2Co 1:9] But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead:
189. [2Co 1:24] Not for that we have dominion over your faith, but are helpers of your joy: for by faith ye stand.
190. [2Co 5:7] (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)
191. [Gal 2:16] Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.
192. [Gal 3:2] This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
193. [Gal 3:5] He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
194. [Gal 3:6-7] Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.
195. [Gal 3:8] And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.
196. [Gal 3:9] So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.
197. [Gal 3:11] But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.
198. [Gal 3:14] That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
199. [Gal 3:22] But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.

200. [Gal 3:24-25] Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.
201. [Gal 3:26] For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
202. [Gal 5:5] For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
203. [Gal 5:6] For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.
204. [Eph 1:13] In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
205. [Eph 2:5] Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
206. [Eph 2:8] For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
207. [Eph 3:17] That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,
208. [Phi 3:9] And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:
209. [1Th 1:7] So that ye were ensamples to all that believe in Macedonia and Achaia.
210. [2Th 2:12] That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
211. [2Ti 1:12] For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.
212. [2Ti 3:15] And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
213. [Tit 3:7] That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
214. [Heb 2:13] And again, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the children which God hath given me.

215. [Heb 4:2] For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.
216. [Heb 4:3] For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.
217. [Heb 10:38] Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.
218. [Heb 10:39] But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.
219. [Heb 11:6] But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
220. [Heb 11:7] By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
221. [Heb 11:11] Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.
222. [Jam 2:23] And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.
223. [1Pe 1:5] Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
224. [1Pe 1:9] Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.
225. [1Pe 2:6] Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded.
226. [1Jo 3:23] And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.
227. [1Jo 5:1] Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
228. [1Jo 5:4] For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

229. [1Jo 5:5] Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?
230. [1Jo 5:15] He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.
231. [1Jo 5:13] These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.
232. [Jud 1:5] I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.
